1. Corporate priority

To acknowledge the importance of an environmentally focussed vision and management

2. Integrated management

To integrate environmental policy as a management parameter

3. Process of improvement

To continue to improve, locally and globally, the company's environmental policy and results

4. Employee education

To improve the environmental consciousness of Danstoker staff

5. Prior assessment

To assess environmental impact prior to initiating new activities

6. Products and services

To develop and provide environmentally sustainable products and services

7. Customer advice

To advise customers on the safe use and disposal of products provided

8. Facilities and operations

To operate facilities and manufacturing processes in consideration of resources and sustainability

9. Research

To contribute to the development of means to minimize the environmental impact

10. Precautionary approach

To modify the company's activities, to prevent serious or irreversible environmental damage

11. Contractors and suppliers

To promote these principles among the company's co-operation partners

12. Emergency preparedness

To develop and maintain contingency plans to minimize the impact of environmental hazards and accidents

13. Transfer of technology

To contribute to the transfer of environmental sound technologies and management methods to industry and the public sector

14. Contributing to the common efforts

To contribute to the development of international-programmes and promote environmental awareness and protection

15. Openness to concerns

To foster openness and dialogue, internally and externally, on environmental issues

16. Compliance and reporting

To follow environmental performance and to provide appropriate information to relevant partners
